Ladies of the Lakes Womens' Club is offering scholarships for 2020. Applications are available through the counselor's office at your school. To apply for this award, you must:

1. Be a graduating senior **and** a resident of Yosemite Lakes Park.
2. Plan to attend a college, university or community college in the **Fall** following high school graduation and have a minimum academic grade point average of 3.50, validated by transcripts. **(This grade point average will be based upon grades received in the academic areas. Other grades, such as P.E., office clerk, etc., are not to be averaged in.)**
Or, plan to attend a Technical or Trade School in the **Fall** following high school graduation and have a minimum academic grade point average of 2.50, validated by transcripts. **(This grade point average will be based upon grades received in the academic areas. Other grades, such as P.E., office clerk, etc., are not to be averaged in.)**
3. Submit a completed Application Packet with three (3) letters of recommendation. **(2 letters must be from someone in the academic arena, such as a teacher, counselor or advisor, and one letter must be from someone outside the school setting. No letters may be from relatives of the student.)**
4. Attach an essay of 240-300 words, answering the following question:
“What do you consider to be your duties as an adult citizen of the United States?”
The essay will be given a weight of 50% of the selection committee's overall ranking in selecting the award winner(s).
